Activity 1

Have a look at the Phase 3 sound mat attached. Check that your child knows how to pronounce all the sounds. Throughout Phase 4 phonics, we are constantly revising phase 3 too!

If there are any sounds that your child is unsure of, practise writing them down in different colours and try putting them into words. Eg.. The sound ure. sure, cure, manure

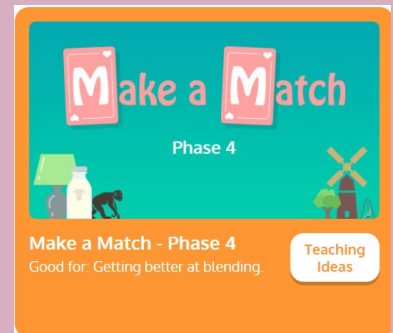
Activity 2

You have to match the picture with the word. The children should be able to read the words independently. Encourage them to segment the word, if they are finding it difficult to read.

Activity 3

Name the alien activity sheet.

Using the letter clusters (2 consonants together) and the vowel sounds (a, e, i, o, u), make up names for the aliens. These names should not be real words but the children should be able to pronounce them using their phonetic knowledge.



Activity 4 - Phonics Play
