# Skimming

Skimming is useful when you want to get a general idea of what a text is about.

When skimming, you ignore the details and look for the main ideas.

Main ideas are usually found in the first sentences of each paragraph and the first and last paragraphs.

# Scanning

Scanning rapidly covers a great deal of material to locate a specific fact or piece of information.

Scanning is very useful for finding a specific name, date, statistic, or fact without reading the entire article.
