What is retrieval?

Retrieval

Over the next 7 lessons, we are going to develop our retrieval skills.

This means that we need to find key pieces of information within the text you are reading.

You need to look through the text for a specific answer. With retrieval questions, the answer you are looking for is always in the text somewhere... you just have to find and retrieve it!

Skimming and Scanning

Skimming and scanning is a skill that can help you find the information you need to retrieve.

What is skimming and scanning?

Skimming

Skimming is useful when you want to get a general idea of what a text is about.

When skimming, you ignore the details and look for the main ideas.

Main ideas are usually found in the first sentences of each paragraph and the first and last paragraphs.

Scanning

Scanning rapidly covers a great deal of material to locate a specific fact or piece of information.

Scanning is very useful for finding a specific name, date, statistic, or fact without reading the entire article.

Skimming and Scanning
