I can create a bank of vocabulary to use in my newspaper report

To make our newspaper report interesting, we need to use exciting vocabulary that hooks the reader into wanting to read the whole report.

### Starting sentence-

Last night the 2018 Winter Olympics began in Canada with an opening ceremony.

### Edited sentence-

Last night, the 2018 Winter Olympics kicked off in style with a two-hour long opening ceremony held at the Olympic stadium in Canada.

What have I done to make this sentence more exciting and engaging?

By adding more detail and changing the vocabulary that is being used, I make the sentences/paragraphs sound more engaging and exciting for the reader. It makes the reader want to read on and find out what has happened.

Starting sentence-

To keep warm in the freezing temperatures, Team USA wore heated parkas during their parade into the stadium.

Edited sentence-

Team USA combatted the freezing temperatures by wearing heated parkas during their parade into the stadium.

What have I done to make this sentence more exciting and engaging?

I have added the word 'combatted' to show how they did what they did.
