Activity 4:

Answers:

Evidence -

Uncle would have been furious at being disturbed - Dog had disturbed him

She hadn't done what she'd been asked to do!

Animals were all out of their cages when they shouldn't have been.

Activity 5

Answers:

The answers are your own opinion as long as they are plausible impressions with evidence to back themselves up

Activity 6

Answers

Impressions - Self Conscious/lacks confidence, self sufficient/doesn't need anybody, pretends to be ok etc.

DO NOT ACCEPT - synonyms of impressions

Evidence must support their impressions appropriately

Activity 7

Answers

You need to state an impression and then find evidence to prove it. You will need two impressions and evidence to gain the three marks!

Activity 8

Answers

Feelings - feelings which are appropriate i.e. he's nervous (evidence: he knows that his classmate is going as the Dad of his character which would be awkward - he changes his mind last minute)...followed by an explanation or evidence. For the 2 marks you need a feeling AND an explanation!

Activity 10

Answers

1. Any two references to the children either not having a home, or children not having enough to eat - this must be word for word though as the question asks for evidence, meaning it's not up for interpretation
2. He feels like he is responsible for being the one to make a change and he talks about by making a change, he needs to make changes to himself first.
3. DO NOT ACCEPT SYNONYMS FOR THE IMPRESSIONS!!!

Impressions - Passionate, Powerful, Determined, Caring/thoughtful etc, a good leader...

Evidence must support their impression
