

As **writers** we will explore a range of genres, learning about the features of a diary and instructional writing. We will continue to develop our grammar and punctuation, producing quality sentences that start with a capital letter and end in a full stop. We will start to check our work to make sure it makes sense.

We will also continue to practice our letter formation and handwriting daily.

In RE we will focus on the Christian faith and will learn about Jesus and how he showed friendship to others.

We will also learn about the Easter story and understand why Palm Sunday is an important day for Christians.

As **mathematicians** we will continue to learn about addition and subtraction and be able to apply our strategies to 2-digit and 1-digit problems. We will begin to develop our understanding of multiplication and division when representing equal groups. We will continue to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

As **musicians** we will listen to some rock and reggae songs learning about the different styles of music. We will learn how to compose our own rhythms by clapping.

As **readers** we will continue to develop our phonic knowledge and spelling rules, enabling us to read with greater fluency. We will use our diamond reading skills to retrieve information from the text and deepen our understanding of what we have read by explaining the answer.



As **scientists** we will learn about the four seasons and be able to describe the weather associated with each season. We will make observations about changes across the seasons and be able to suggest some reasons for the changes in seasons.

As **athletes** we will develop fundamental movement skills: throwing and catching. We will also develop our badminton skills, learning how to hit the shuttlecock.

As **artists** we will learn how to develop a collage based on extreme weather and to use different printing techniques to create a wave print in the style of Katsushika Hokusai.

As **geographers** we will learn about amazing weather around the world, exploring the climate in tropical, temperate and cold places.
